Dr Gail Ewing is a Senior Research Associate at the Centre for Family Research, University of Cambridge.

Dr Ewing co-developed the Carer Support Needs Assessment Tool (CSNAT) with Professor Gunn Grande (The University of Manchester). The CSNAT comprises 14 broad domains identified by family carers and as key areas of support in palliative and end of life care. The tool has been validated with current carers in palliative and end of life care and an extensive programme of research has now been completed. The CSNAT has also been implemented into practice both nationally and internationally.
